### In the beginning...

- Prosecuting Attorney's Office Children's Services Division—12 divisions—primary and educational--Advocate
- Roles—caseworker/opposing attorneys/magistrate(judge)
- legal work vs social work
- collaborative -- collegial -- Adversarial

## Order of Case Hearings

- Initial problem/investigation/arrest
- Request for Legal Action
- Complaint Filed [PC/TC/PPLA/PSUPP]
- Day1/Day 7 Hearing [probable cause]
- Trial (evidence presented) [clear & convincing]
- Decision (Adjudication)
- Sentence (Disposition)
- Objection to the "Report" of the Magistrate
- Appeal to 1<sup>st</sup> District Court of Appeals
- Appeal to Supreme Court of Ohio

## Legal Timeline

- VAC expires 30 days after <u>signing</u>
- Adjudication & Disposition must be made 90 days <u>after</u> complaint filed
- Interim hearing must be held after 180 days of complaint filing
- Annual Review must be held within 365 days of complaint filing
- Objection to Report of Magistrate must be filed within 14 days of date of Magistrate's Order
- Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days of Juvenile Court's decision

Judicial Pyramid—State of Ohio Court Hierarchy

Ohio Supreme Court

1st District Court of Appeals (for Hamilton County)

Common Pleas Courts (Hamilton County Juvenile Court included)

Municipal Court [misdemeanors & traffic violations]

#### The Trial

- Who goes first
- Caseworker role—professional, respectful, honest
- How to respond to questions
- Follow up questions
- Cross examination
- Hearsay evidence—when & where admissable
- "your opinion"
- Normal witness order—CW/Police or 1<sup>st</sup> Responder/Records—Medical—Technical

#### After the Trial

- Debriefing
- Explanation
- Objections or Appeal
